**Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Commission (FCHRC)  
Scholarship**

**Objective:** This scholarship is available to any Cumberland County high school, private school, and home school graduating senior for financial assistance towards his/her attendance to a two or four-year college or university of their choice.

**Administration of the Program:** The Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Commission will use the following criteria to determine a student's eligibility for receiving this scholarship. All applications and records of awards will be kept by the Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Department.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

1. Student has resided in Cumberland County at least one year immediately prior to applying for this scholarship;
2. Student will be a senior in a high school located in Cumberland County;
3. Student has maintained an average of 2.50 GPA (unweighted) or better; and
4. Student has been admitted as a full-time student in an accredited course of study to a two or four-year college or university.

**Amount of Scholarship:** \$1,000

**Requirements:**

1. The application must be filled in completely, including the information requested in numbers 12 through 14, which should be submitted on additional pages by **April 8, 2020**.
2. An official high school transcript must accompany the application; and
3. Three letters of recommendation must accompany the application packet, letters **must be signed or applications will be considered incomplete**.
