I agree that I am responsible for ensuring activities at the site are done so in a manner that will not cause damages to street pavement, curb and gutter, sidewalk, or any other infrastructure. I agree, if any such damages occur, I am legally and financially responsible for any and all repairs of said damages and will make any such repairs immediately. I understand that any improvements made by me may be disturbed, altered, or removed, as needed, for repairs, improvements, or upgrades to any and all infrastructure by the City of Fayetteville and/or any utility provider. I agree to notify the City Construction Management Division (910) 433-1798 when proposed work begins and when it is completed. I understand that this permit is valid for thirty (30) day from issuance. If the encroachment exceeds 30 days, I understand that I must apply for a new permit and pay additional fees.

If a pathway cannot be provided, "SIDEWALK CLOSED" signs and appropriate safety measures shall be installed and an alternate accessible pathway shall be provided by the applicant or their contractor.
