It is the responsibility of the applicant to inform ALL personnel on the project site that the meter is energized!!

NCEC 10.8.2:

1. The service wiring and equipment, including the meter socket enclosure, shall be installed, the service wiring terminated, and the service equipment covers installed.
2. The portions of the electrical system that are to be energized shall be complete and physically protected.
3. The grounding electrode shall be complete.
4. The grounding and the grounded conductors shall be terminated in the service equipment.
5. At least one receptacle outlet with ground fault circuit interrupter protection for personnel shall be installed with the circuit wiring terminated.
6. The applicable requirements of the North Carolina Code apply
 - Please note the approval from City of Fayetteville does not guarantee the energizing of the meter if the utility provider's requirements are not met.

Process:

A separate temporary power application must be created on the City of Fayetteville's E-Development portal. If this application is uploaded into the construction project, it will be rejected. Once the request permit for temporary power is created, the applicant will have to request an inspection. If the inspection passes, the City of Fayetteville will issue a temporary power permit and notify the appropriate electrical utility provider that it meets the North Carolina Electrical Code requirements on temporary power. This is NOT a guarantee that the electrical meter will be energized if the utility provider's requirements are not met. Permit and authorization is valid for 60 days, if more time is needed then use the post approval upload on your temporary power application to upload a new permit application.
