

Home with code enforcement violations

CODE ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS

The city employs 13 staff members to cover all Code Enforcement operations. One Manager, Two Supervisors, Nine Inspectors and One Administrative staff member.

Operations are from 7am to 6pm Monday through Friday. Special assignments may take place after hours.

Each of the nine Inspectors is assigned a territory that includes over 20.000 residents and dozens of neighborhoods and developments.

Inspectors use a variety of sources and databases to determine property ownership and occupant information.

In a typical year, the Code Enforcement Division will manage 13,000 cases of which 4,000 are citizen complaints and 9,000 are Inspector generated.

MISSION

Code Enforcement works to protect residents and visitors to our city by enforcing codes and standards. Some of those include:

- Overgrown properties
- Trashy properties
- Junk, nuisance & abandoned vehicles
- Permits for construction & renovations
- Permits for sheds, fences and signs
- Sign standards enforcement

- Zoning enforcement uses of property
- Minimum standards on dwellings and buildings
- Dangerous and Blighted buildings
- Heavy truck and trailer parking
- Graffiti
- Basketball goals in the street

Code enforcement issues notices to property owners/violators giving time to gain compliance. Failure to comply in most cases will result in the issuance of civil penalties. In some cases, continued violation of the city code can result in criminal charges being filed.

*In some examples, junk vehicles may be towed and overgrown vacant properties may be cut and cleaned.

Who You Gonna Call?

A guide to connect you directly with who can answer your question best.



- My neighbor's grass and weeds are very tall and/or has trash and debris in the yard.
- My neighbor is storing furniture, car parts, building materials and/or household items outside.
- My neighbor's pool water is dirty/green/full of debris.
- My neighbor has a car that is crashed or dismantled parked in the yard or street.
- A car has been parked in the street for a long period of time and not moved.
- My neighbor has a tractor trailer parked in the street or the front yard.
- My neighbor's *house*, shed, garage, pool, fence, etc. is in *disrepair* and needs to be repaired.
- My neighbor built something that does not look like it meets code (too large, too close to other structures, etc.)
- My neighbor is running an auto repair business at the house.
- My neighbor is operating a business out of the house that creates noise or traffic.
- My neighbor's *lights are too bright* and are shining on my property.
- The vacant house down the street is unsecured and people are entering.
- There are homeless people living in the woods in the neighborhood creating trash.
- The vegetation and weeds on the vacant lot beside me are growing into my property or against my fence.
- I have concerns about a trailer, boat or camper my neighbor has parked in the driveway, street or yard.

NSPECTION

CODE

ENFORCEMENT

- I am trying to get a *permit* for a fence, shed, sign, renovation, new build.
- I am trying to call for inspection or get inspection results.

SOLID WASTE RAPID

- My neighbor has *piles of debris* by the street/curbside (furniture, leaves, limbs, logs, construction debris, etc.)
- There is *illegal dumping* on or near the street.
- My neighbor never moves his trash cans from the street.

POLICE

- There are people speeding in my neighborhood.
- There are suspicious people in my neighborhood.
- My neighbor is making too much noise. (loud music, cars, machines, etc.)

CIVILACTI

BETWEEN OWNERS

- My neighbor's *tree fell* into my yard.
- My neighbor's tree is leaning and may fall on my property/house.

LANDLORD\TENANT ACTION

 My single family house I lease/rent has an infestation of bugs.

MISCELLANEOUS

- All animal related issues such as loose dogs, barking dogs, people with farm animals or roosters, animals in distress.

- The *road* in my neighborhood is *damaged* or *signs* are missing or damaged. Traffic Services
- The (house, apartment, mobile) home I rent has mold. NC State DHHS
